### **What is the EdSAFE AI Fellowship?**

The EdSAFE AI Fellowship is a leadership development program designed to connect and empower underrepresented thought leaders in artificial intelligence (AI) in education. Through interactive workshops, mentorship, and a collaborative capstone project, Fellows gain a deeper understanding of AI's ethical, safe, and equitable use in education. The Fellowship is not full-time.

### **Who is eligible for the EdSAFE AI Fellowships?**

The Catalyst Fellowship is open to individuals who are passionate about the use of AI in education and who identify as:

- Educational leaders: This includes administrators, teachers, researchers, and policymakers who are interested in exploring AI's potential to improve learning outcomes.
- Open for worldwide applications!

The Women in AI Fellowship is open to individuals who are passionate about the use of AI in education and who identify as:

- Women technologists: This includes women working in AI development, data science, or related fields interested in applying their skills to education.

- Educational leaders: This includes administrators, teachers, researchers, and policymakers who are interested in exploring AI's potential to improve learning outcomes.
- Open for worldwide applications!

### **What are the benefits of participating in the EdSAFE AI Fellowship?**

Fellows will:

- Gain expertise: Learn from world-renowned experts in AI and education through interactive workshops and discussions.
- Build a network: Connect with a cohort of like-minded peers and mentors passionate about AI's ethical use in education.
- Make a difference: Apply their knowledge to develop a capstone project addressing a real-world AI education challenge.
- Amplify their voice: Contribute to the global conversation about the responsible use of AI in education.

### **What is the time commitment for the EdSAFE AI Fellowships?**

The Fellowships are a 12-month program typically requiring a monthly commitment of 2-4 hours. This includes attending virtual workshops, participating in group discussions, and working on the capstone project.

### **How much does it cost to participate in the EdSAFE AI Fellowships?**

The EdSAFE AI Fellowships are fully funded, with no participation cost.

### **Is there an honorarium?**

No honorarium or compensation is associated with either EdSAFE AI Fellowships.

### **What is the deadline for EdSAFE AI Fellowship applications?**

Applications are due by December 1, 2024, at 10 p.m. EST. We will not accept applications submitted after this date and time.

### **What is the selection process for the EdSAFE AI Fellowships?**

Selections are made by a selection community representing a diversity of perspectives and organizations within the EdSAFE AI Alliance. The selection process is competitive and based on a variety of factors, including:

- Demonstrated commitment to the ethical use of AI in education
- Leadership potential
- Diversity of experience and background
- Quality of application materials

**When will I be notified if I am selected for a Fellowship?**

Successful applicants will be notified in December 2024 and January 2025.

**When does the program start?**

The program is a 12-month Fellowship starting in January 2025.
